- Where did you initially suspect Owen had gone and why?
- What do you think Owen wanted to happen after he left?
- Did Owen make the right decision in leaving as he did?
- Did the flashbacks to "happier times" change your impressions of any of the characters or how they got to the present?
- How would you have felt in Hannah's shoes if Owen were your husband?
- How would you have felt in Bailey's shoes if Owen were your father?
- What made Bailey dislike Hannah at first?
- Discuss the questions Hannah had about her predicament and what questions you would have had.
- Would you have attempted to uncover the truth as Hannah did?
- Did any of the answers Hannah found surprise you?
- What do these truths reveal about Owen's character?
- Hannah is a unique character in a unique predicament. How would you describe her and her motivations?
- Would you have made the same decisions for the future as Hannah?

- Discuss Hannah's, Bailey's, and Owen's views on love.
- Discuss the role of trust in The Last Thing He Told Me and the characters' views on it.
- How did Hannah change over the course of The Last Thing He Told Me?
- How did Hannah's and Bailey's relationship change over the course of <u>The Last Thing He</u>
 Told Me?
- Discuss the difficulties of stepparenting.
- Discuss Hannah's views on motherhood and parenting.
- Discuss Hannah's experience as a child of each of her parents (and step-parent).
- What do you think will happen in the future for these characters?
- What was your first reaction after turning the final page of The Last Thing He Told Me?
- The Last Thing He Told Me is very thought-provoking. Did you find yourself thinking about it long after you read it?
- What genre would you categorize <u>The Last Thing He Told Me</u> as -- mystery, thriller, suspense, family drama, or something else?
